



Presents the 10th Annual Big Ring Dirt Road Race Series
Held Under USA Cycling Event Permit 2010-3231

The Big Ring Dirt Road Series is about to roll out for 2010!

Races will be held in the Wichita, Kansas area.

Cyclocross bikes are recommended but not required.

All racers must have a current USA Cycling license or purchase a one day permit on race day.

Races will be held on dirt/gravel country roads. Surfaces may include but are not limited to: dirt, rocks, mud, gravel, dust, ice, snow, sand, and even pavement.

Restrooms or changing areas are not provided, so take care of business before you arrive!

The surfaces are varied and the terrain will make each race very challenging. The roads are open to traffic and wildlife. Each rider is expected to obey ALL traffic laws and laws of nature.

Entry Fee: \$25.00 per stage. Fees include \$3.00 for USA Cycling insurance / \$1.00 for KCA surcharge

All 2010 USA Cycling Rules apply. Events will be held rain or shine. CPSC approved Helmets must be worn at all times on the bike.

Valid and current USA Cycling license required or one day license (\$10.00 per day) must be presented at registration.

Cat 1, 2, 3 Starts at 1:00 p.m.

Cat 4, 5 Starts at 1:05 p.m.

#1 November 7, 2010 “Musher’s Mayhem” (5 laps)

Indianola Road and US-54 Highway (3 miles east of Andover Road on US-54) Park at West Butler County Office parking lot (do not park at Airport Parking Lots). This course is a 6 mile loop with varying terrain.

#2 November 14, 2010 “Gordon Ring” (6 laps)

Gordon is located 7 miles south of Augusta on 77 Highway. Park along road/street in Gordon. The Gordon loop is 5 miles, with a great switchback climb and straight and fast downhill.

#3 November 21, 2010 “Towanda Ring” (6 laps)

Towanda is 16 miles east of Wichita on 254 Highway or 7 miles west of El Dorado on 254 Highway. Park at Circle High School. (East edge of town) This 5 mile loop has several tough hills and a low water bridge crossing to negotiate.

Back up course “Douglass Ring” (7 Laps)

Douglass is located 13 miles south of Augusta on 77 Highway. Park at the Douglass High School Parking Lot. The Douglass loop is 4 miles, with two climbs per lap.

Each week points will be awarded to all riders that finish in each race.

Points will be awarded as follows: 1-25, 2-22, 3-19, 4-17, 5-15, 6-13, 7-11, 8-9, 9-7, 10-5, remaining finishers will receive 3 points each.

The rider with the highest point total at the end of the series will be declared the Big Ring Dirt Road Series Champion. The series champion in the “123’s” race will have their name engraved on the Big Ring Dirt Road Series trophy displayed in the Bicycle X-Change Shop at 908 West Douglas.
